If you want a free discount App, these two are the two essential ones to get:

UNIDAYS is amongst the most popular apps for students, with loads of different brands offering student discounts including Apple, JD Sports, Hollister, Levis, Nike and Foot Asylum amongst others. Download the App and sign up for free at **www.myunidays.com**

Making student life a little sweeter and a lot cheaper is www.Studentbeans.com which works in a similar way to UniDays, but has exclusive deals with selected brands which are only available on it's App. It's free to sign up and Student Beans was the first digital Student discount app in the market, having launched in 2005 and has thousands of student deals, giving access to more savings than any other student ID card.

Both UNIDAYS and Student Beans have been around for a while now and are continuously improving to provide students with a variety of discounts across retail, food, tech and more. It's a no brainer that you'd would want to save money and use both of these student discount websites. There's no harm to signing up to both of them and getting the most of these during your time studying.

If you're looking for a specific deal, **www.vouchercloud. com/student-discount-guide** is a handy hacking tool, which shows all the different student deals available and which discount scheme they are available on, so it's also worth using this as a reference.

Food wise, students looking to reduce their food bill should sign up to **www.toogoodtogo. com** which offers discounted 'Surprise Bags' at the end of each day from restaurants and food shops. It allows outlets to sell surplus food for a third of its original selling price, rather than throwing it away. 12 things to do in Bristol that cost nothing

THE DOWNS

Get some fresh air and stretch your legs in one of the cities biggest parks. Situated at the top of Whiteladies Rd and very near to the Stoke Bishop / Wills & Hiatt Baker student halls , this is a huge area of protected parkland that neighbours Clifton and the Avon Gorge. Perfect for running, walks, football and lazv summer BBQ's.

M SHED

Located in a huge 1950s transit shed right on Bristol's Harbourside, the M Shed museum explores over 2000 years of Bristol's history and is free to enter. Learn about Bristol People and Bristol Places and keep an eye out for the special exhibitions on the top floor.

SPIKE ISLAND

One for the art fans, Spike Island is an international centre for contemporary art and design. The Gallery is free all year round and hosts exhibitions from world-renowned artists.

CLIFTON SUSPENSION BRIDGE

Bristol's most famous attraction, the Clifton Suspension Bridge is totally free to admire, walk across and take that all important selfie with. There are also free guided tours of Clifton Suspension Bridge at 3pm every Saturday, Sunday and Bank Holiday from Easter to October. You'll find your volunteer guide by the Clifton Toll Booth (Bristol side of the bridge) wearing a high vis jacket. You can also book special tours into the vaults underneath the bridge. Don't forget to Slide down the Clifton Rock Slide near Bristol Observatory, a strip of glassy rock that has been smoothed by thousands of Bristolian bums over the years.



SEE THE STREET ART

Home to Upfest, Europe's biggest Street Art festival means it's not just Banksy that has street art to write home about, Bristol's walls are an ever-changing free gallery of incredible art and there's always something new to discover. Check out the Bristol Art District in Bedminster with over 150 murals, at www. bristolartdistrict.com or one of the numerous Banksy walking trails and street art guided tours.



CABOT TOWER AND BRANDON HILL

Visit Brandon Hill to climb the 105ft Cabot Tower for panoramic views of the city below. Given it's very near Park St, the surrounding park is a perfect chill out spot between lectures with some great views. Random fact, back in 2009, Red Bull built a temporary ski slope here too, look it up on YouTube.

ASHTON COURT ESTATE

On the outskirts of the city, by the UWE Bower Ashton Campus, you'll find Ashton Court Estate, 850 acres of woods and grasslands, complete with herds of deer grazing in the woods. Activities include mountain biking, football golf, and Treetop Adventure course. And walking trails, loads of them! It's also home to the cities biggest music festival, Love Saves the Day on 25-26 May 2024.

ST NICHOLAS MARKET

Take a wander through St Nicholas Market, established in 1743 and Bristol's oldest market. Soak up the smells, sights and sounds of the covered halls and glass arcade and browse more than 60 stalls. Make sure you check out the 'Nails' brass pillars located outside the market on Corn Street. Dating from the late Tudor/early Stuart period they were used for the Exchange of money between traders and customers.

BUMPSY TRAIL

An anonymous street artist with a fetish for drawing Mr Bump has created over 120 pieces across Bristol. Now known as Bumpsy, they are mainly located in North Bristol, so is perfect for students living in the Stoke Bishop halls. See if you can visit them all, this 33km trail is a starting point: https://leave-the-road-and.run/mr-bumps-friday-route-recommendation/ and can be done on foot, bike or e-scooter. Personal highlights are the family of 'Mr Bump's alongside the river and the Abseiling Mr Bump on the Portway, complete with climbing rope.

LEIGH WOODS

Explore the beautiful and diverse woodland on the plateau above The Avon Gorge. Once home to a huge Hollywood inspired 'Bristoland' sign welcoming visitors into Bristol, Leigh Woods has been a haven for Bristolians for decades and offers grassy glades, shady woodland and alternative views of the Clifton Suspension Bridge. The woods also have various running and mountain bike trails, both official and off piste.



TREASURE ISLAND TRAIL

Take the free Treasure Island Trail around the Bristol's Harbour and explore Bristol's connections with Robert Louis Stephenson's Treasure Island. The walk is about a mile long and will take you to eight 'Black Spots' that highlight the story in sequence around the city. You can find the Black Spot barrels yourself or download the app for £1.99. This is a perfect excuse to devise as an alternative pub crawl with some history thrown in for good measure.



ESCAPE TO THE SEASIDE

Only 30mins away by train, the quintessential English seaside, Weston-Super-Mare boasts miles of sandy beach, perfect for beach sports and fabulous sunsets. Let's not forget the Grand Pier and various one off events at the Tropicana – last summer it hosted a full size, decommissioned North Sea oil rig.

TOP 10 LOYALTY CARDS TO SAVE AS YOU SPEND

Tesco Clubcard

Tesco.com

You'll earn points on your Tesco Clubcard every time you make a purchase you get one point for every £1 you spend (or one point for every two litres of fuel you buy).

How much are Clubcard points worth?

Every point is worth a penny when you're buying items in Tesco. However, you can also trade them in for discounts at a huge range of high street stores and brands, making them stretch even further. You'll receive vouchers based on the

number of points you've collected every three months (usually every February, May, August and November). You can either spend the vouchers in Tesco as they are, or use the codes on the vouchers to spend them with one of Tesco's Reward Partners instead – often doubling the value of your points.

Nector Card

nector.com

Best known as Sainsbury's loyalty card, but you can also collect points from hundreds of different brands including Argos, eBay and Expedia. Please note that with many of these, you can only collect points when you shop online. At Sainsbury's, you'll earn one point for every £1 you spend.

How much are Nectar points worth?

How much Nectar points are worth when redeeming them varies depending on where you're shopping. In Sainsbury's, one point is worth 0.5p, so 500 points will get you £2.50 off your shop. At Sainsbury's, you can now also benefit from discounted items with your Nectar card.

Co-op Membership

www.coop.co.uk/membership

Co-op membership costs £1 to join and that doesn't count towards your points. When you buy selected Co-op branded products and services, 2p of every £1 goes into your Co-op Membership account. You can then spend this on anything in Co-op food stores (not just own-brand products).

Boots Advantage Card

www.boots.com

You'll earn points every time you make a purchase at Boots online or in-store. You'll receive three points for every £1 you spend, so a £20 spend would get you 60 points. Every point is worth 1p to spend in-store or online, so the 60 points from a £20 spend would be worth 60p.

Superdrug Health & Beautycard www.superdrug.com

You'll earn one point for every £1 you spend. You can only spend your Superdrug points in multiples of 100. 100 points will get you £2 off and so on... However, the best thing about the Superdrug loyalty card is that, unlike the Boots Advantage card, you can use your points for part payments. So you can buy something that costs £4.99 and use 200 points to get £2 off, paying the difference (£2.99) yourself.

Subway Rewards

Once registered, you'll get one point for every 10p, but if you haven't registered your card, you'll have to spend 20p to

get a point (and you won't be able to redeem your points for freebies). Here's what you can buy with your points:

- 100 points Free hot drink
- 200 points Free snack
- 500 points Free six-inch sub, flatbread or salad
- 1,000 points Free footlong sub or flatbread.

Nando's Card

www.nandos.co.uk

You'll earn a 'Chilli' every time you spend $\mathfrak L 7$ or more on your meal. You need to register your card online or on the app first, and you'll receive a bonus Chilli for doing so.

You can only collect one Chilli per customer per day, so even if you spend £14, you'll still just get one stamp. So, if you're dining with a fellow Nando's cardholder, make sure you pay separately to maximise Chilli earnings. When you earn a certain amount of Chillies you'll be able to claim a reward. Here are the freebies you can get with a Nando's Card:

- Three Chillies (Green Reward) 1/4 chicken, three chicken wings or starter
- Six Chillies (Orange Reward) 1/2 chicken or any single wrap, burger or pitta
- 10 Chillies (Red Reward) Whole chicken or single combo meal with regular sides or a salad or bowl.

Waterstones Plus

Earn one 'Plus stamp' for every £10 you spend in-store or online, and every 10 stamps will add £10 to your Plus balance. For spends between £5 and £9.99, you'll earn half a stamp. So, broadly speaking, for every £100 you spend, you'll get £10 off – and this includes money spent in the cafe. And, with a Waterstones Plus Student card, you'll get an extra 5% off all purchases, along with collecting the Plus stamps.

Starbucks Card

Earn three Stars for every £1 you spend. These Stars stack up and, once you've collected enough, you'll earn a reward — including free coffee. Essentially, this card is only worth getting if you tend to use Starbucks a lot as you need to preload the loyalty card first before buying anything.

Costa Club

You'll get one bean for every drink you purchase. You can also collect beans at Costa Express machines, which you'll often find in supermarkets or service stations. 10 beans will get you one free drink in-store. While you can earn beans at the Costa Express machines, you can't use them to redeem your free drink. Or, to get your free drink faster, each time you use a reusable cup in store you'll get an extra bean. That means you can actually get a free drink for every five you buy, all whilst helping save the planet!

H&M Membership

You will get one point for every £1 spent online or in-store at H&M. Membership is completely free and when you join, you'll receive 10% off your first purchase.

H&M membership comes with a bunch of rewards including special member prices, bonus vouchers, free delivery on orders over £30 and 25% off any item on your birthday. For every 100 points you earn, you will get a £3 bonus voucher. So in money terms, you need to spend £100 to get a £3 reward.
